
Policy/Procedure Name: Members attaining CPCS-CPMSM Certification	Index: UAMSS-009

Policy Statement:

In recognition and to support UAMSS members and Non-Members in their professional development.

Procedure:

1. After each test cycle (Spring and Fall,) the President will confirm with the NAMSS Director at Large individuals who have obtained their certifications from the state of Utah.
2. Using the obtained list the President will determine which individuals are current members. Those identified as non-members will be provided to the membership committee for a follow up invitation to UAMSS.
3. The President and/or the Treasurer will issue a \$50.00 check for each newly certified member during a monthly board meeting.
4. The attached congratulatory letter and check will be mailed to the newly certified member.
5. In the event, that the newly certified member has obtained dual certifications, the check shall remain \$50.00.
6. Non-Member Certifications will get a congratulatory email/mail from UAMSS Board.
